Gian Carlo Delgado is a guest researcher within the CLiSAP visiting fellowship program until July 3rd. He is hosted by the Research Group Climate Change and Security (CLISEC) and the Postdoc-Fellow Juan Miguel Rodriguez Lopez.

Gian Carlo is a full time researcher at the Interdisciplinary Research Centre on Sciences and Humanities of the National Autonomous University of Mexico and professor at the Faculty of Social and Political Sciences and the Faculty of Sciences at the same University. He is a member of the National System of Researchers of the National Council on Sciences and Technology of Mexico and research project evaluator of the National System of Scientific and Technological Evaluation (SINECYT).

Gian Carlo has been a lead-author of Chapter 12 on "Human Settlements, Infrastructure and Spatial Planning", of Working Group III (AR5) of the 5th Report of the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change. AR5-WG3 Report can be downloaded at: http://mitigation2014.org/.

His research focuses on urban metabolism analyses, uneven development and climate change policy. He has published as an author, coauthor or editor, 24 books, in addition to more than 100 scientific papers published in America, Europe and Asia.

He received the National University Prize for Young Researchers in 2011 and the Mexican Academy of Sciences Award 2014, both for his contributions to social science research. The latest is the Academy's highest award and one of the most important scientific recognitions in Mexico.
